

Mission – The Food Pantry served 13 families representing 44 people in March. They also provided 3 meals each serving about 24 people for those at the Light House Shelter in Washington. SPPRC: Jason will work to submit the report, "Another Set of Eyes." Old Business: The baptism of the Schultz child is on hold. New Business: Ainsworth Community Church was approved for a CARES loan up to \$8300 to assist with payroll and utility expenses. This is through the Small Business Assoc. It covers 2.5 months of estimated expenses. Jan and Jason are working to develop a calling team that will reach out to members of the church during Covid-19.
