<u> Parish Council Highlights</u>

Following are highlights from the May 8 meeting:



<u>Finance</u>: Colleen reported nothing unusual with our finances. She paid Randy Arthur for snow removal; she will contact our property manager again about paying her. Jo usually does not want reimbursement until the account is current. Committee Reports: <u>Worship</u>: Bibles are on backorder for Senior Sunday but will be delivered individually. <u>Christian Education</u>; Will work with UCC for Vacation Bible School to be held August 1-4; Farm Theme. <u>Membership/Nurture</u>: Sent Easter Cards and provided

food for Ruth Miller funeral (not held at ACC). Property: More lights have been switched to LED in South Church; a few more still to complete. Furnace - Adam reports he still has no response from the two companies. *Concrete*: Bruty is ready to start concrete work on May 9. Jason will contact the committee for final approval of work because some details were missing from the original bid. The Council unanimously agreed to give the Property Committee final approval over what work was completed. Additionally, the cost of concrete has increased since the bid last year. The new *doors* are still on hold. <u>Mission:</u> – They will meet with Pastor Jason on May 9 to make a decision about the Convoy of Hope program. During the month of April, 8 families (27 individuals) were served at the Food Pantry. Memorial Committee, SPPRC, Nominating Committee: No report. Old Business: New toilets in Fellowship Hall - Jan and Jason will speak to Steve Miller (4M); Maverick Jaxon Havel was baptized on April 9, 2023 at ACC. Brynn Rose Carstensen was baptized on April 16, 2023. New Business: Disaffiliation: Attorney reviewing our papers found that our buildings were never really transferred to ACC – instead they still belong to the denomination. Council chose to leave as it is for now; *Presbytery* is scheduled to come to a joint meeting with ACC/UCC on Sunday, May 21 to answer and collect questions. Greg Freyenberger has access to a *website* that the church could link to our homepage. The purpose of the site is to help plan for college – expenses and estimate potential future earnings. There would be no cost to the church. It was agreed to share all the details with Colleen to have her co-workers review. Add to agenda for June meeting. The next Parish Council meeting will be Monday, June 12 at 7 PM via Zoom.
